

Mad Dog Motorcycle Club (MDMC) 4th Annual Poker Run

MT SAMAT/SBMA POKER RUN – SATURDAY 13th February 2010

This poker run is a charity run for the Mad Dog Motorcycle Clubs Many Charities we support. With your help we can make this Annual event very successful. The route chosen will without a doubt be a memorable one that will take riders through the scenic winding back roads of Bataan! The actual roundtrip route will take us from Angeles City to Dinalupihan, continue south into Bataan past Balanga where we will then take the Mt. Samat turnoff and continue to the town of Morong and then onto the back side of SBMA (Subic Base). We will continue through SBMA and down the end of the Toll way back to A. C., or for Bikes under 400CC they will have to travel the Main gate or Kalayaan gate or the Kalaklan gate and go the Zig zag road back toward Dinalupihan where we will enter onto the National Highway then continue into Dinalupihan and back into Angeles City. Total throttle time is 4 to 6hrs. This is a must ride for riders that have never been on this loop before!

Poker Run Fee:

The poker run fee is only 300 Pesos. You will receive one poker hand and one hell of a nice ride! A 2nd poker hand is allowed for another 300 Pesos (remember this is for charity!). The 2nd poker hand will be available to you by the "OFFICIAL CARD COUNTER" at Checkpoint #5 (The Angeles City Balloon Festival) upon your return and prior to 5pm.

Prizes:

There will be a 1st Prize is P5,000.00, 2nd Prize is P3,000.00 and 3rd Prize is P2,000.00 awarded and issued at The Balloon Festival. This will be issued on or about 5:00pm. YOU NEED NOT BE PRESENT TO WIN BUT IT IS GREATLY APPRECIATED IF YOU ARE THERE THROUGHOUT THE PRESENTATION!!!

Times and Rules:

Leave (The Angeles City Balloon Festival between 8-10am). Return by no later then 5pm! (This is to prevent riding after dark!) Riders can leave anytime between 8-10am. Riders can ride in large groups, small groups or solo, it doesn't matter. Riders are encouraged to ride at their own pace, take their time, enjoy the route, stop and do whatever they want along the way, just as long as they arrive and check in with the "OFFICIAL CARD COUNTER" at Checkpoint #5 no later then 5pm!

The Angeles City Balloon Festival Start and sign up point and Finishing point!!!

(Checkpoint #1: Start Point Mad Dog Booth at Angele's City Balloon Festival.)

(Checkpoint #2: Total Station at the Hermosa, near Dinalupihan.)

(Checkpoint #3: Petron Gas Station on the Mt. Samat Route in the town of Bagac.)

(Checkpoint #4: Petron Gas Station on SBMA, near Pure Gold and Royal SBMA (just before the Toll road that leads off SBMA to the National Highway or SCTEX to Angele's City)

(Checkpoint #5: Final check point The Angeles City Mad Dog Booth at the Balloon Festival where you must arrive no later then 5pm!)

Total Kilometers depending on route taken is approximately 220. Also as stated above the average throttle time is 4 to 6 hours to complete the route depending on your bike and travel speed you will travel for your comfort. Lets all have a great day 13th February 2010.

NOTE: These are Official checkpoint opening/closing times and their locations!

Checkpoint #1 Opens at 08:00am and closes at 5:00pm (Mad Dog Motorcycle Club Tent Balloon Festival)

Checkpoint #2 Opens at 09:00am and closes at 2:30pm (Total Hermosa, Near Dinalupihan on way to Balanga)

Checkpoint #3 Opens at 10:00am and closes at 3:30pm (Petron Bagac along Mt. Samat Route)

Checkpoint #4 Opens at 10:30am and closes at 4:00pm (Petron SBMA)

Checkpoint #5 closes at 6:00pm (The Mad Dog Motorcycle Club Tent at the Angeles City Balloon Festival)

NOTE: Stops, Breaks, Meals, are up to each rider. There are many places to eat when you're on SBMA. Maybe one of the most popular restaurants on the route (and on the water) would be Vasco's.

THE RIDE is from 8:00am to 5:00pm to follow with winner awarding WITH THE ANNOUNCEMENT OF PRIZES and other activities around 5PM!!! LET'S MAKE THIS CHARITY EVENT A GREAT ONE!!! AGAIN YOU NEED NOT BE PRESENT TO WIN BUT WE WOULD REALLY LOVE TO HAVE AT THE PRESENTATION!!! Let's be SAFE and enjoy a GREAT RIDE DAY!!!

NOTE: There's a possibility because we are using multiple decks of cards that someone can end up with "5 of a kind" (example: 5 Aces). So not to complicate things... we will make it "the strongest hand wins" regardless! Five Aces will beat four Aces and Five 2s will beat 4 Aces! And if there's a tie for any position, then the riders that are tied must each draw one card from the deck until their winning positions can be determined (highest card wins the tie-breaker). But the one draw back to using multiple decks of card is that it's possible that someone could have a "straight" going but then they end up with two of the same identical cards, that would break up the "straight" (Example: like a Ten, a Jack, a Queen, and then two Kings of the same suit), that would suck, but that would just be the luck of the draw, **They loose!**

The three different routes are before Checkpoint #2 so it doesn't matter which route the riders take into Bataan.

MT. SAMAT/SBMA was chosen for this poker run because of its long scenic winding road, no traffic, it's quite and peaceful, most anywhere along the route is safe to stop for breaks and/or work on bikes, a lot of out-of-town riders have never had the chance to enjoy this route, etc. You must come see it for yourself!
